U.S. raises tariffs on non-CUSMA Canadian goods to 35%, adds 40% transshipment penalty. Canada responds with surtaxes.

The tariffs, imposed in a series of Executive Orders in a short timeframe, have been the subject of litigation and attempted Congressional action.

Canada's counter tariffs on steel, aluminum and automobiles remain in effect as intensive negotiations with the U.S. continue. This is in recognition that the U.S. maintains tariffs on these sectors, ...
