Will bifacial solar panels be exempt from tariffs?

In his announcement, the President included an exemption for bifacial solar panels. This decision comes after the ITC recommended in November 2021 to extend the safeguard tariffs for an additional four years.

Why are bifacial panels exempt from tariffs?

Bifacial panels were originally exempt from the tariffs because there was no significant domestic manufacturing capacity of the specialty product. This caused more bifacial modules to be imported into the United States than monofacial panels, undermining the objectives of the original safeguard measure.

Did Biden put bifacial solar panels back under Sec 201 tariffs?

The Biden Administration today put imported bifacial solar panels back under Sec. 201 tariffs, after the specialty solar panels enjoyed a two-year exemption from extra duties first initiated by President Biden in 2022.

Could a bifacial solar panel exemption be ended?

Notable discussions include potentially ending the 15% bifacial solar panel tariff exemption from the Trump era and a pending petition that could escalate tariffs for solar panels and cells from Southeast Asia, regions that are primary alternative manufacturing sites for Chinese companies previously affected by tariffs.
